Created by local businesses, artists, families and kids, the gingerbread houses will sit amidst a winter wonderland in the first floor gallery surrounded by large format photographs: David J. Murray's images of *Vintage Christmas in Portsmouth* and photographs of trains in New Hampshire winters by Andy Dolph. The exhibit can be seen every day through December 22 from 9:30am – 5pm with extended hours on Friday November 30, Saturday December 1 and Friday, December 7 until 8pm. The exhibition is free and open to the public at Discover Portsmouth, located at 10 Middle Street. Jurors' selections are announced at the Kickoff Party. The public can continue to vote until Friday December 14 for the People's Choice Awards. These awards will be announced on Monday, December 17 on Facebook.
